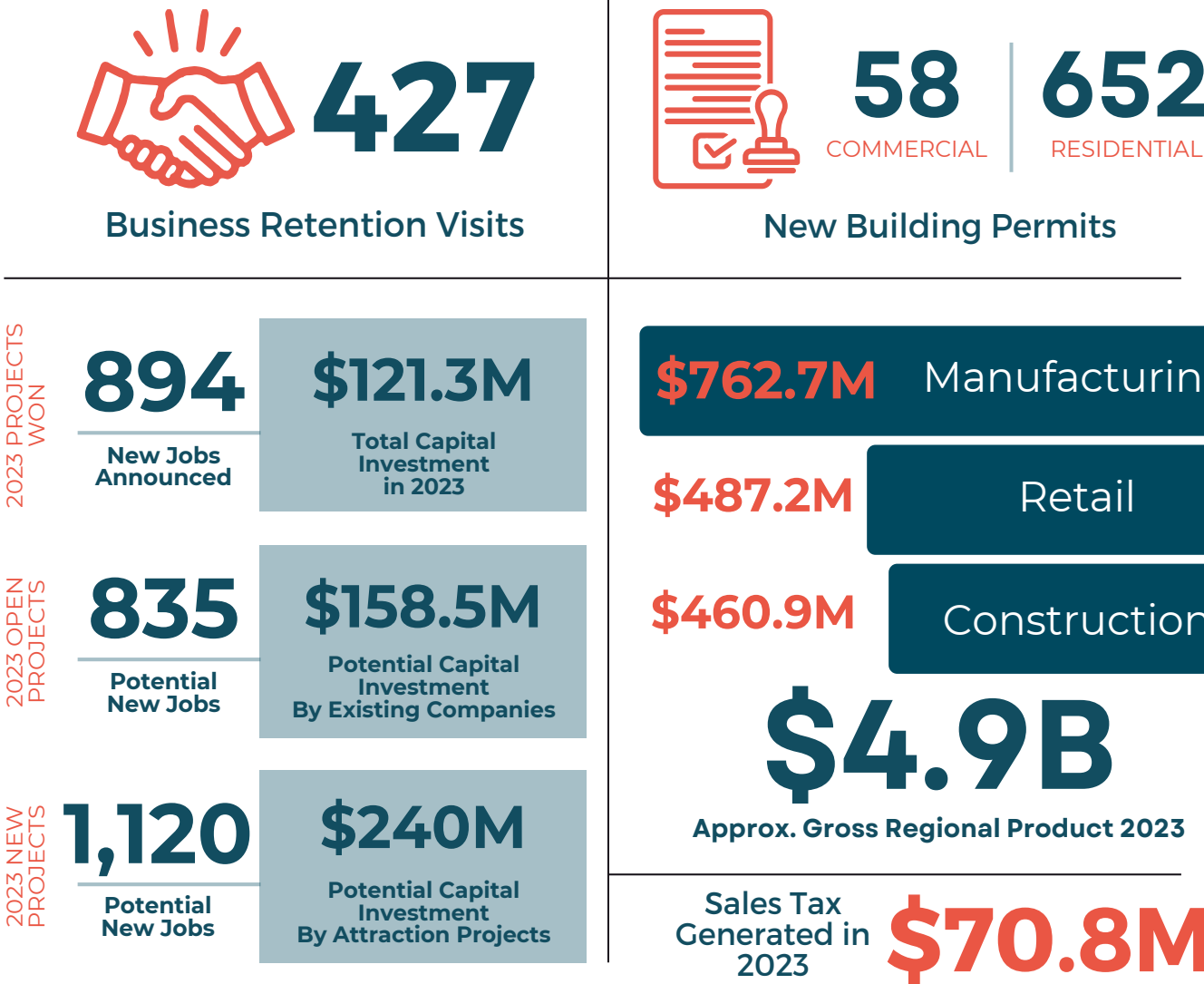

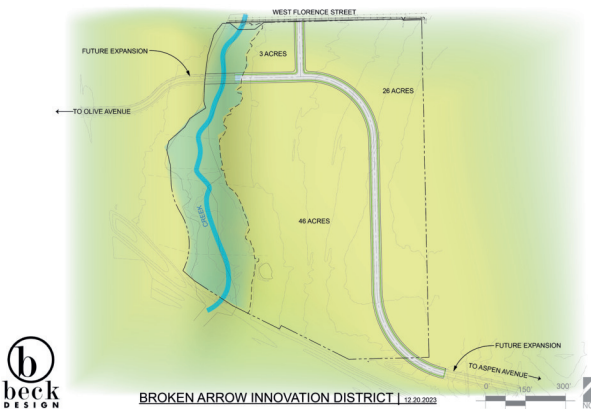

Situated on 90-acres in South Broken Arrow, the City of Broken Arrow in partnership with the Broken Arrow EDC have laid the groundwork for an advanced manufacturing district to build upon the manufacturing foundation that has shaped Broken Arrow for decades. The district is designed to foster collaboration among cutting-edge industries, create an ecosystem for entrepreneurs, and train and upskill our local workforce.
